



Tennessee QSO Party 2014



Yet another TNQP has come and gone. I'm afraid activity was down a bit this year. We have 18,610 QSOs reported. We're going to push hard to activate all 95 counties in 2015. The chase for the USA-CA (USA Counties Award) drives quite a bit of QSO Party activity.

K1GU arranged for the ARRL Centennial W1AW road show to stop in Tennessee during the QSO Party. W1AW/4 was a second bonus station, on the same basis as K4TCG. The operation proved very popular, making more than 1,200 QSOs and breaking the old TNQP score record. (however, K4TCG did even better)

This year, all QSOs counted for three points regardless of mode. Some entrants' software didn't yet reflect this change. Most operators weren't aware that W1AW would be a bonus station until after the contest. For those two reasons, 62% of entrants will find their actual score below is higher than the score they claimed. Our two Japanese entrants worked one QSO each and claimed three points. However, in both cases that one QSO was W1AW – and their scores were increased to 103.

23% of entrants got it exactly right. Their claimed scores will match their scores below. 14% will see score reductions. The largest reduction was 20% but nearly all reductions were of less than 7%. You'll lose a QSO if the QTH you log disagrees with what the other station sent. You'll also lose a QSO if someone else claims to have worked you and we find a call very similar to his in your log at the same time & on the same band and mode. For example, one entrant claimed a QSO with "KE4ZS" in Davidson County at 1827z on 40 phone. We have a log from K4EZS. Mark is in Davidson County. And he claims a QSO with the entrant in question at 1827z on 40 phone. Mark gets the points, but the QSO has been scratched from the other log.

12,535 CW QSOs were reported; that's almost exactly 2/3 of the total. The other third was of course on phone. I'm afraid only 27 digital-mode QSOs were logged. As with past years, 40 meters is the "money band" with 60% of activity. 23% was on 20 meters, and 14% on 80. 2.6% of activity was on 15. A handful of QSOs were made on 160, 10, and VHF. Tennessee participants worked 42 DXCC Entities on all six continents. All fifty states were worked, although W4UT was the only entrant lucky enough to find North Dakota! 83 of the 95 counties made it into logs. Eight of Canada's ten provinces were worked.

We have our first million-point score. This year's K4TCG operation starring K4RO, K4UU, and WF7T broke the multi-op high-power mixed mode record, and the seven-figure barrier. W4JUJ broke their own multi-op low-power phone mark. N2WN broke his own score record in the mobile QRP CW category. And first-time entrant WN4AFP broke the single-op low-power phone record.

And now, the numbers. A = Award (P in this column means Plaque). R = TQP record score. 1 = First-time entrant.
