It will be easier for us if your log is in the Cabrillo format and conforms to the following template. Please note that other file formats (including ADIF) frequently lack important information, such as your callsign & address!

## Notes:

1. All times are UTC.
2. The ARRL-SECTION: tag is used to identify whether you're in Tennessee or not. If you are, please enter **TN**. If you aren't, please enter a valid ARRL section for your state/province. A list is available on the ARRL website at <http://www.arl.org/section-abbreviations>. If you aren't sure which section you're in, guess. It's only important that it be in the right state/province. DX stations: enter **DX**.  
If your log has both ARRL-SECTION: and LOCATION: tags, the logchecking process will use whichever appears last. Please make sure whichever one appears last contains a valid section.
3. Frequency can be any frequency in the appropriate amateur band, including "placeholders" like 14000.
4. Please name your file {YOURCALL}.log. (ie: K4TCG.log)
5. Please send your file as an attachment to an email. Don't copy-and-paste it into the email body – many email clients will mangle the text.
